Essential Job Functions

- Be properly registered and certified through USAH.
- Provide feedback and assistance to the team's head coach.
- Be prepared for practice and games.
 - Be at all on and off-ice practices.
 - Communicate absences to age specific on-ice division director.
- Communicate with the Head Coach and Division Director about availability.
- Communicate possible adjustments and/or improvements to the management of the team and/or parents.
- Offer insight that helps improve player development, IE, Little Mikey has a learning disability so extra explanation may be needed.
- Assist in the execution of on and off-ice practices as assigned by the head coach and/or directors.
- Assist in the development of parent culture through positive reinforcement and support of RRHC Core Values, coaching philosophies, and development plan.
- Understand all of the practices, plan and assign drill and coach the key points of the drill as intended.

- Minimum 1 year of previous coaching experience
